Travel Fellowship is available to students and young professionals presenting papers at the 2nd Symposium on Advances in Geospatial Technologies for Health in Arlington, Virginia, USA, August 24-30, 2013. Fellowship will be limited to US citizens who will be presenting at the meeting. The presenter must be the first author of the paper and a major member of the research team. Fellowships are anticipated to be a maximum of \$1,200 per person.

The following criteria will be used to rank applications:

- **Quality of the paper**

In addition to the abstract, an outline of the paper is required to briefly describe the Objectives, Background, Methods, Results and Conclusions of the study with a maximum of three pages. Full paper may be required later to be published in a peer reviewed journal as a special issue for this symposium. However, the author will retain the full right to publish in a journal of his or her own choice. The submitted document will only be used for fellowship selection process.

- **A financial plan for attending the meeting** (including other sources of funding).

- **Letter(s) of recommendation from a faculty advisor and/or supervisor.**

- **One-page CV** (please include your current GPA if currently a student, and publications and presentations).

Each fellowship recipient will pay for his or her own travel expenses and registration. An amount of fellowship will be issued to the selected individual.

Application deadline is June 30, 2013
