Antarctica: Catching snow in the world's southernmost desert

Measuring snowfall anywhere is a challenge — but perhaps nowhere more so than Antarctica. Accurate snowfall measurements there are critical for understanding how the continent's ice sheets are changing, but hurricane-force winds and frigid temperatures have made such measurements nearly impossible. NCAR Scientist Scott Landolt is testing new technologies that might finally make accurate snowfall measurements in Antarctica possible.
