### **About the Girls in Science Event:**

In an effort to provide unique and thoughtful programming we are hosting our first “Girls in Science Night” on Friday, February 8th, 2019 from 5:30-7:30pm at the Museum. This event will be specifically geared for girls ages 3-8. The theme of the evening is “How to Be a Scientist,” with the hopes of demonstrating to girls that they can be a scientist both as a future career and right now in their everyday lives! Girls will explore various fields of science through hands-on experiments with actual female scientists. We hope to leave 75-100 girls equipped with the skills and knowledge about how to approach their worlds through the lens of a scientist. At the end of the event, the attendees will be encouraged to participate in a “Community Science” project, documenting evidence over the next six weeks at home. Then, on Friday, March 22nd, attendees will be welcomed back to the Museum for a pizza party and to share the results of their Community Science findings.
