Chris has been in the environmental and energy space for almost 20 years and has worked with all levels of government to bridge the gap between science and policy. These experiences have given him a unique insight to address environmental challenges in the state of Colorado. In 2019, Chris proposed 26 bills, of which 23 passed. He has also created the Colorado Science and Engineering Policy Fellowship designed to increase the presence of undergraduate and graduate students with STEM degrees in public policy.
