

PhD Positions at University of Sassari

The Department of Economics and Woody Plant Ecosystems (DESA) at University of Sassari offers a Doctoral Course in "Agrometeorology and Ecophysiology of Agricultural and Forestry Ecosystems". The Course is part of both Doctoral School "Agricultural and Forestry Ecosistems and Food Production Science" at University of Sassari and Doctoral School "Global Change, Science and Policy" at University of Venice (Cà Foscari).

The Doctoral School "Global Change, Science and Policy" is funded by **Euro-Mediterranean Centre for Climate Change** (<u>CMCC</u>).

Objectives

The doctoral program address agriculture, forest, and environmental problems. Our program integrates the biological and physical sciences to provide advanced education in basic and applied biometeorology and ecophysiology, develops critical and analytical abilities, and fosters the capacity to conduct research into the structure and functioning of ecosystems at different scale levels.

The three-year course requires that a student takes courses, seminars, and conducts a specific research program with emphasis on one of the following fields:

- Analysis of climatic impacts on agriculture and natural ecosystems
- Micrometeorology of agricultural, forestry, and natural ecosystems
- Ecophysiology of Mediterranean ecosystems
- Climatic analysis and land suitability
- Biometeorology and Bioclimatology
- Fire risk and propagation
