The Department of Earth and Space Science and Engineering invites applications for a full-time tenure track appointment in Space Science at the Associate or Full level to commence 1 July 2009 or as soon as possible thereafter. All positions at York University are subject to budgetary approval.

Space Science at York University focuses on the study of the atmosphere from space, including the design and use of satellite instrumentation, the analysis of satellite data, and related areas (see www.yorku.ca/esse for more details.) The successful candidate must have a proven record in space instrument development and the capacity to lead major space science projects. Familiarity with the Canadian space program will be an asset. The successful candidate is expected to already have or develop strong externally funded research programs and show strong commitment to teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels. The Department of Earth and Space Science and Engineering is affiliated with the Centre for Research in Earth and Space Science (CRESS) which has excellent facilities for the development and test of space instruments.
