**9th IAGA - ICMA/IAMAS - ROSMIC/VarSITI/SCOSTEP  
workshop on  
'Long-Term Changes and Trends in the Atmosphere'  
to be held in Kühlungsborn, Germany  
19-23 September 2016**

This is the second announcement of the well established biannual „trend workshop“ which takes place on 19-23 September 2016 in Kühlungsborn, probably the most beautiful sea resort in Germany.

The most important topics of this workshop are:

1. Observed trends and long term variations in the middle atmosphere
2. Modeled and predicted trends and long term variations in the middle atmosphere
3. Trends and long-term changes in the ionosphere and thermosphere
4. Dynamic, physical, chemical and radiative mechanisms of trends and long term variations
5. Role of the middle atmosphere for climate

The workshop is co-sponsored by IAGA, ICMA/IAMAS, the ROSMIC program of VarSITI (SCOSTEP), the German Space Organisation (DLR), and the German ROMIC research initiative of BMBF.

- **Registration**:

  - Onsite: 280 Euro regular, 230 Euro for students
  - Accompanying persons: 50 Euro (independent of time of registration)
