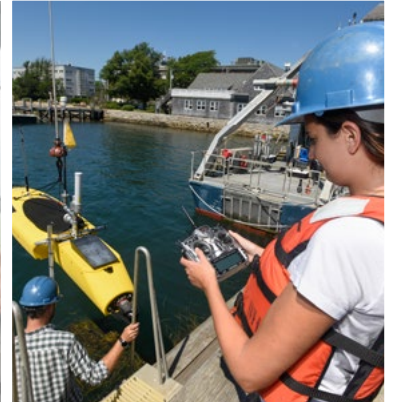

## Summer Student Fellowships

Each fellow conducts a research project under the guidance of a member of the Scientific Staff. Fellows have the opportunity to select and pursue a project of their own with access to more than two hundred practicing scientists and engineers and the facilities of a major oceanographic institution. Fellowship recipients also participate in a one-day practicum research cruise. This program aims to provide hands-on experience to students with interests in ocean science, ocean engineering and/or marine policy.

### Eligibility

Undergraduate STEM majors who will have completed their junior year are eligible. Students from underrepresented groups are encouraged to apply.

**Timeframe** – The program is held during the summer months. Students arrive between the end of May and mid-June and stay for 10-12 weeks.

**Stipend/Travel/Housing** – A weekly stipend of \$680 per week is provided for the 10-12 week program plus a round-trip travel allowance. WHOI housing is also provided.

**Deadline** – Completed applications are due by *February 5, 2024*.
