The Cooperative Institute for Modeling the Earth System (CIMES) at Princeton University in collaboration with <u>NOAA's Geophysical Fluid</u> <u>Dynamics Laboratory (GFDL)</u> is recruiting undergraduate students for 8-9 week research internships in atmospheric, oceanic and earth system science.
