The Hans Brenninkmeyer Fellowship for Coastal Research supports two-year postdoctoral appointments. Fellows work on a research project focused on an environmental issue in Buzzards Bay.

The expected start date of the 2025 Fellowship is between June and September 2025.

Brenninkmeyer Fellow candidates will choose from pre-selected Research Topics, and if invited, develop a research plan to address the topic in collaboration with their co-advisors. Brenninkmeyer Fellows will work closely with their advisors at both the Buzzards Bay Coalition and their partner institution and have access to the facilities of both organizations (e.g., laboratories, field sites, boats, libraries, previous data sets). Brenninkmeyer Fellows are expected to publish their results in peer-reviewed scientific journals.

The Fellow will receive a salary of \$70,000 per year plus benefits and a \$20,000 research support fund that can be used over the course of their fellowship to support their research by covering the cost of things such as supplies, journal fees, and conference participation.

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
